# 1 Executive Summary

The Contra Cancrum external website has been designed and created in order to serve as the first point of information for the research community on the objectives, approaches, and results of Contra Cancrum. In addition, the website provides services such as email and videoconference in order to also serve as a collaborative environment for members of the consortium. The web-site will be continually updated during the project.

### 2 Introduction

This document presents a short description of the Contra Cancrum website. This has been done with Google Apps technology, allowing the use of a number of tools to be used.

The main actions taken so far are:

- User accounts for have been created for all Contra Cancrum partners and email redirections to their permanent email addresses have been set.
- Specific email lists have been created for all WPs (1 to 10) of the projects in order to facilitate communication within each WP. Also, an email list for management issues has been created as well as a list for all project participants. For security reasons, only users with administrating rights can add and/or remove people from the list. This can be done from a web interface.
- From the website, the Contra Cancrum members can easily access a site for document sharing, providing also other useful services (e.g. chat, calendar, videoconference).
- After several efforts, the use of the website has been explained in detail and all the partners have already adopted its mail and document services. This ensures that there is a dedicated functional space for each user with only the Contra Cancrum relevant emails and documents and facilitates communication using WP lists.




Figure 1: The Contra Cancrum website




Figure 2: The Contra Cancrum email, calendar and document services interface
